It is the purpose of the Suttons Bay-Bingham District Library to provide materials and services which will furnish opportunities for educational, informational, cultural and recreational enrichment to all of the people of the communities served by the library.



In this annual report we'll take a look at 2023, and hear from the presidents of the Library's Board of Trustees and the Friends of the Library.

Of note during the year was the library's return to more consistent programming, post-pandemic. For youth we offer a weekly Story Time year-round. During the school year, we offer a monthly Family Fun program when families can engage in creative play activities together. We offer a six-week Summer Reading program; last summer we explored the theme *All Together Now* and are looking forward to the 2024 theme, *Adventure Begins at Your Library*. In the spring and fall the library's Friends group provides book give-away events for kids to celebrate March is Reading Month and Book-or-Treat in October. For adults we offer a monthly book discussion called BOOKENDs, and we offer technology presentations called Tech Tuesdays in the spring and the fall.

These regular programs are in addition to joint offerings with community partners including the public libraries of Leelanau County, LIFT, Inland Seas, NES Migrant Education Program, Leelanau 4-H and Interlochen Public Radio. You may have seen us at local daycares, in the schools, during the Leelanau Senior Expo or at a Suttons Bay Chamber of Commerce event. It's great to be part of our community.

Speaking of community, in 2023 the library began an update of the lower level Community Room to better serve your needs. We cleaned, organized and painted to better use the space available. We installed mobile tables and chairs, flexible storage and soft seating. We have also brought the space up-to-date with the addition of new video conferencing equipment and boosted the wi-fi in that area.
